

Cost is \$30 per pet. All Microchip Clinics are held at the shelter, located at 1201 28th Avenue North in Fargo.

Microchips are very small, about the size of a grain of rice. Each microchip contains a unique number that can be read by a scanner and will then identify the current owners information, being very beneficial if your pet should every end up missing. Please consider microchipping your dog or cat at the next Humane Society Fargo-Moorhead Microchip Clinic.
