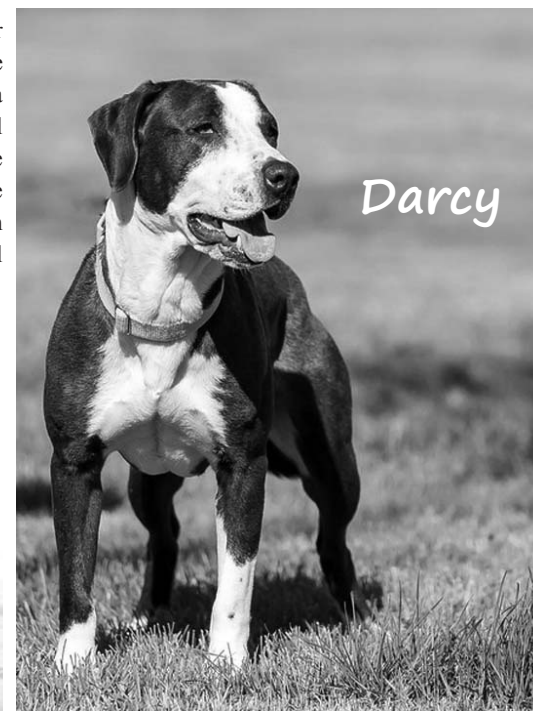
## Patiently Awaiting A Forever Home
