Sadly, while they were at the shelter the pair had to be kept in isolation due to feline herpes which is a chronic respiratory infection or "kitty cold" that includes sneezing and watery eyes. The condition does not decrease their life span and is not contagious to humans (or canines) but is contagious to other cats. Supplements like lysine powder and low-stress environments help reduce such outbreaks. When they were 9 months old, the pair was lucky enough to find someone who was willing to take them in together and love them with their "kitty colds" and all. Their adopter, Hannah Als-
